*Research training and education in Cognitive Science:
the International Master at the University of Trento:*

Abstract: Cognitive Science is concern with the scientific study of the mind/brain system adopting an interdisciplinary approach. The Master in Cognitive science aims at enabling students to develop an advanced knowledge and understanding of the theoretical and methodological traditions that inform the study human cognition in the areas of Cognitive Neuroscience (Track CS-CNS) and Language and Multimodal Interaction (Track CS-LMI). The MA can be regarded as way of furthering personal and professional development, culminating in the distinction of a postgraduate degree in Cognitive Science, or as a stepping stone for doctoral research in one or more of these areas at the University of Trento.

The MA program is based in the Faculty of Cognitive Science - FCS, which provides a highly active and interdisciplinary environment involving linguists, cognitive psychologists, neuroscientists, philosophers and AI researchers. FCS is associated with the Department Cognitive Science and Education - DiSCoF and the Center for Mind/Brain Sciences – CIMeC and attracts large numbers of research fellows and distinguished academic visitors. Interdisciplinary dialogue is encouraged by weekly research seminars and international workshops.

The Language, Interaction and Computation Laboratory (CLIC) is an interdisciplinary group of researchers interested in studying verbal and non-verbal communication. Research in the laboratory uses both computational and cognitive methods.

In the seminar, examples from some of the research lines presently active will be presented.
